Subject: Corona/Covid19 regulations 2021 for the International St. Moritz Automobile Week

Dear motor sport friends,

unfortunately the pandemic still has us in its grip. Although the measures seem to be relaxed compared to 2020, the implementation is definitely more complicated than last year. This fact has again caused numerous organizers to postpone or completely cancel their events this year.

However, we decided early on to take up the challenge again in 2021 and to launch not only the Bernina Gran Turismo, but also two new events, the Kilomètre Lancé and the Motorsport Rendezvous.

However, this can only be done in compliance with the so-called 3G rules and has the following consequences:

At all events of the International St. Moritz Automobile Week, the number of people (participants plus visitors) is limited as follows:

Kilomètre Lancé: up to 1,000

Motorsport Rendezvous: up to 500

Bernina Gran Turismo: up to 1,000

Although the 3G rule would have to be applied only for the groups over 500, we will follow the 3G rules also for the Motorsport Rendezvous, so that everyone can move within the event without wearing a mask.

This means that every participant (and every visitor) will be checked accordingly when they arrive. Therefore, be sure to bring appropriate proof - ideally via app on your smartphone, or at least as a printed proof with QR code. We recommend the "COVID Certificate" app (Switzerland) or the "CovPass" app (Germany, which is available for download in the relevant platforms:



We then check your status using the Swiss app "Covid Check", which also recognizes certificates from other countries:



You will also be required to show identification at the time of verification so that we can determine whether the certificate and person match.

We assume that our target group is mostly vaccinated (or recovered) due to the age structure. However, since we cannot automatically determine what your status is with the Covid-Check app, we ask for your permission to show us the "certificates" or "more info" in the app. This is the only way we can determine if you are vaccinated or recovered, which we may be satisfied with a one-time status check. On the other hand, if you are tested, this test must not be older than 48 hours. Moreover, in this case we have to check you daily, as our events may last longer than 48 hours. Also, if you do not want to show us the "certificates" or "more info", we must check your status daily.

Consequently, you have to be tested again in time when the test expires!

For this purpose you can use e.g. the test center of the Polyclinic St. Moritz. This is located in the St. Moritz spa, conveniently situated on the Piazza Paracelsus between the Kempinski and the Forum Paracelsus. You can register online in advance or on site at <http://www.polyclinic.ch/covid-19-test> to be tested free of charge. The test center is open daily, including weekends, from at least 10 am to 6 pm.

Please understand that you can only participate in our events if your status has been successfully verified. There are no exceptions.

You will be checked for 3G status directly when you arrive at the check-in in the race office (Kilomètre Lance') or in the "Guarda" room (Kempinski). As long as you are in the "public area (including the hotel), you are obliged to follow the rules in force there (distance, wear a mask if necessary). The facilitations of the 3G regulation apply when you are in the cordoned off event area.

Access to the check-in at the Kempinski Grand Hotel Des Bains will be via the courtyard to the Saal Guarda, as last year. The exit for those successfully checked in is via the lobby. In the race office of the Kilomètre Lance there is a corresponding "one-way-rule".

Successful verification will be confirmed by putting on a participant wristband.

The respective evening events will take place in gastronomic establishments, each of which is responsible for compliance with the applicable regulations.
